
Digital English Club

The Anambas Islands are a beautiful, remote archipelago in Indonesia, and have increasingly become a popular destination for tourism, which boost economic activity. However, despite the rapid development, the local community faces a significant challenge: limited access to English education that hinders their ability to participate in the growing economic opportunities.

In 2019, during our initial assessments in the villages of the Anambas Islands, a consistent need emerged: head of villages and community members highlighted the importance of English language skills for their children's future. In response, Anambas Foundation set up digital English classes for elementary and middle school students, partnering with an Indonesia-based language-learning platform. While we recognize that offline language learning is often more effective and engaging, the remote location of the villages makes online classes the most practical way to reach students at this time.

Beyond language skills, Anambas Foundation integrates lessons on environmental conservation and waste management in DEC classes, instilling sustainable practices and values in young learners. At the moment, the DEC program is being implemented in five villages, with plans to expand to two additional villages.

Kiabu's remote location presents both challenges and opportunities. The lack of schooling options beyond middle school and limited digital connectivity restricts young people's educational opportunities. DEC aims to bridge this gap by bringing English education to Kiabu, equipping middle school students and local youth with the skills to become key players in the growing tourism sector. A reliable internet connection, such as through a satellite-based internet service, would significantly expand educational access and the chance for students and local youth to connect with resources beyond their village.

However, beyond digital access, Kiabu's students and youth would benefit immensely from an on-site English teacher. Having English-speaking volunteers live in Kiabu would provide hands-on language immersion that digital classes alone cannot offer. Daily interactions and consistent lessons from these volunteers would help students gain confidence and fluency in English—skills essential for future opportunities in tourism and beyond. By learning English directly from volunteers embedded in their community, students and local youth would receive both structured education and valuable real-world practice, giving them a solid foundation to engage meaningfully in the tourism economy.

TO BRING OUR VISION FOR DEC IN KIABU VILLAGE TO LIFE, WE NEED YOUR SUPPORT:



We are seeking volunteer English teachers who can commit to teaching in Kiabu for six months to one year. Volunteers will be provided with lodgings, daily meals, and round-trip transport from Batam to Kiabu. In this role, teachers will bring crucial language skills to young learners, equipping them with English language skills for further education and work opportunities.



Installing a satellite-based internet terminal in Kiabu would be a transformative step, providing the village with reliable internet access, giving the village residents access to information, education, and economic opportunities.
